We wish to announce that next Sunday, February 2, we celebrate the Feast of the Meeting of Christ in the Temple. This Feast commemorates the bringing of our Lord into the Temple on the 40th day following His Nativity in fulfillment of the Old Testament Law and so brings to an end the Nativity Season that began 80 days ago with the start of the Nativity Fast. Since Christ is the Light of the World, we show symbolic acknowledgment of this with the blessing of candles on this Feast.

As next Sunday, February 2, is also the day on which the NFL Super Bowl is played, we commemorate this day as "Souper Bowl Sunday". On this occasion we take up a special collection to support the work of our Diocesan St. Andrew's Society in its work in supporting and maintaining soup kitchens in Ukraine. We will have our Special Collection Bowl out next Sunday and we encourage everyone to give generously to support this ministry.

We wish to announce that on Saturday, February 8, the next meeting of the All Saint's Camp Committee will be held at 10:30 am at Saints Peter and Paul UOC in Youngstown, Oh. Let us pray for the continued work of the Camp Committee and the continued ministry of All Saint's Camp.
